
NAIDOC Week runs from July 2 to 9, during the school holidays. The City of Fremantle will be hosting many moorditj events during the break. Follow the link for further information:

As is evident from the pie charts, there are very clear winners! Due to popular demand, the willie wagtail (djidi-djidi), banksia (mangatj) and kangaroo paw (yongka maar) will feature alongside the red-tailed black cockatoo (karak) and New Holland honeyeater (bandin) in our school mural.
